



IV ADMIXTURE AT SHIFA PHARMACY

Intravenous admixtures are the mixing of two or more parenteral preparations in a hospital to meet individual patient's therapeutic needs. Intravenous medications are prepared in a clean room under aseptic (sterile) techniques in Laminar Flow Hoods to avoid contamination. Labeled and packed, then dispensed in ready-to-use form to floors where they are simply administered. Intravenous admixtures are prepared by qualified and trained pharmacists or by technicians under supervision of pharmacists.

- Accuracy and precision in reconstitution of drugs.
- Safe preparation/dilution of medications by trained staff.
- The final preparation has the right dosage, the right quantity, the right dilution, the right container, and the right label.
- Patient specific & individualized preparations.

- In pharmacy frequently administered medications can be prepared in batches which decrease both labor and waste.
